Education is a channel that ignites the young minds and is also instrumental in raising responsible future generations of the society. There are these young minds who have been deprived of quality education due to lack of financial aid or infrastructure facilities. In lieu of this, we adopted Government school at GirigowdanaDoddi in April 2010. Since then, we are constantly engaged in various useful activities to enhance the skills of the students, who can't afford access to education at private schools.

While the rest of the country decides to go on a holiday, Preranaites have the privilege to celebrate Independence Day and Republic Day with the students, to create a sense of patriotism amongst the students. Flag hoisting, sports activities, cultural activities and various competitions have been part of our celebrations. Students have shown umpteen enthusiasm in the celebrations and won prizes.

On 28/09/2015 A new program was added to our list, “Ayurveda Awareness Program” in association with Health Club, NMKRV College where students interacted with village people and demonstration of Ayurveda medicines to villagers. Eye check-up and dental check-ups were also conducted to help the students and villagers of GiriGowdanadoddi to stay healthy. NMKRV College has generously handed over a bench to this school.

While the present generation believes joy is in expensive celebrations, Prerana takes the pride of celebrating its every anniversary with these school kids and marks simple, yet memorable celebrations with these school kids.

To prevent people dying due to blood loss, more and more donors should step forward. With blood shortages occurring worldwide, it is important to create a network of young blood donors who commit to donating regularly. Prerana is a liaison between the donor and the soul in need of it. Prerana is successful in conducting blood donation camps in association with Indian Red Cross Society, at various educational institutions, corporate organizations and public events.

We have created awareness amongst the public about the importance and benefits of donating blood. Till date we have helped Indian Red Cross society collect more than 1000 units of blood.

Prerana has been constantly organizing blood donation camps at NMKRV college for women, Jayanagar since 2012. We are happy to share that we have successfully collected more than 600 units of blood throughout our camps at NMKRV till date. The students and the staff have always shown ample enthusiasm and interest in stepping forward to donate blood.

The organizers and students of JIT have equally carried out abundant energy and interest in conducting successful blood donation camps. We have collected about 150 units of blood at JIT and BMS.

FREE EYE AND DENTAL CHECK UP CAMP

“Useless to Dead, Priceless to blind. One eye donation can help two blinds to see. So, Donate Eyes. After all, it gets buried with us after we are dead. Let your eyes light brightness in somebody's life”

Most of the population in India live in the economically backward areas of the country, where they have little or no access to primary health care facilities.

One of the most important senses of our body is vision- our eyes. For our brains to function in a healthy way, we need a healthy eyesight. 80% of what we perceive comes through our sense of sight. Our eyes have been called " the window to our soul". The World Health Organization estimates that 80% of all causes of visual impairment are preventable or curable.

Understanding this importance, Prerana has pledged to promote access to eye Care facilities among the economically weaker sections.

Prerana organized a Free Eye camp at Marenahalli Government School. Doctors from Lions Eye hospital treated around 110 children.

Free Eye camp was organized for the children of Government School, Yediyur. Doctors of Lions Eye hospital treated around 500 students from class 1 to 10.

The secret behind a confident smile lies in its oral care. It is essential to care for our oral health as it affects our social life, career and relationship. Maintaining good dental hygiene is essential to lead a positive life. Understanding this Prerana has organized various camps to promote access to dental care.

We have conducted eye and dental screening camps in association with RV dental College, Lions Eye Hospital and Nethradhama eye hospital. We have covered many villages and schools. To name a few, Government School, Yediyur, Hosadoddi village, Aralalsandra, Bidadi, GirigowdanaDoddi. Team Prerana thanks each and everyone who participated in eye and dental screening camps.

Team Prerana sincerely appreciates the efforts of RV Dental College for reaching out to around 120 patients and also Nethradhama for reaching out to close to 90 patients who needed primary care.

We visit the old age home very often and hand out medicines, sponsor one day meals and spend quality time with them. We always return with the blessings of those contended hearts who treat us as their children. We also celebrate New Years at Belaku Old Age home, bringing a new hope of life for the inmates. We also visited Belaku Girl Orphanage where we donated stationary essential for their education and sponsored a day's meal.



Prerana also had opportunities to visit Vatsalya Charitable Trust over the years where we conducted many cultural activities, provided educational support and sponsored meals.
